MBA Qualification Descriptor

The Master of Business Administration (MBA) qualification at UCL is awarded to students demonstrating the knowledge, skills, attributes and values required to successfully fulfil senior leadership roles in complex and changing environments.

characteristics in their design and delivery:

1. The MBA qualification is a professional education portfolio aimed at enabling the professional development of students with management and leadership experience. Programmes must be designed, delivered and marketed accordingly, and should utilise the professional experience already within each cohort throughout and beyond the programme.
2. The MBA qualification at UCL is aimed at students with previous work experience and particularly suits those who have demonstrated their potential to take on more senior leadership responsibilities. The amount and nature of the previous work experience required will be carefully design of the programme. This must be at least
