### 3. Funding availability

#### 3.1. Duration

Funding is available for a maximum of two years. Successful candidates will be asked to submit a progress report mid-way through their appointment. Fellowships are generally expected to be undertaken on a full-time basis without breaks, although part-time applications will also be considered. **Please note that funding is only available for a maximum of two years, whether you are applying for a full-time or part-time position.** EPSRC Doctoral Prize fellows who wish to request an exception to this should contact the EPSRC Doctoral Training Manager well in advance of submitting applications for change as prior funder
